District Enters Stage III Of the Drought Contingency Plan

As a result of the severe drought conditions, the Centerville Community Services District has declared a **Water Shortage Emergency** and has entered into **Stage III** of the **District's Drought Contingency Plan**. This stage calls for an immediate 50% reduction in water use consistent with the drought plan.

As of March 4, 2022, the District has a total of only **1,050 acre-feet (AF)** of water available for use during the entire 2022 Water Year, which goes from March 2022 through February 2023. This includes the 150 AF purchased from the McConnell Foundation. In comparison to the previous Water Year ending February 2022, the District used a total of 1,860 AF. <u>Considering the significant drop in water supply it is critical that our customers increase conservation immediately</u>. At this time, there is no other known water supplies available for purchase. This means that immediate conservation is required so that the District can stay within the available water.

In the coming days you will be receiving more detailed information regarding Stage III and what it means to you. It will include a personalized water budget specific to your service address as well as provide other useful information regarding the Drought Contingency Plan Stage III and how to read your meter.

Please see the back of this newsletter for the District's Water Budget for the 2022 Water Year. This table will show you how much water is used (or projected) for the month and whether or not we have stayed within our budget.

OUTDOOR IRRIGATION RESTRICTIONS

Outdoor use of potable water – <u>All customers must reduce outdoor use of potable water by</u> <u>adhering to the following restrictions:</u>

- Outdoor irrigation is permitted <u>only</u> between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 pm to 12:00 am on the days described below:
 - a. Addresses ending with an <u>odd</u> number may water only on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday and only within the permitted time period.
 - b. Addresses ending with an <u>even</u> number may water only on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday and only within the permitted time period.
 - c. For repair purposes only, outdoor irrigation systems can be operated between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. for a reasonable period of time not to exceed five (5) minutes per zone cycle and only long enough to verify proper operation and make sprinkler adjustments.

Centerville's Water Budget 2022 Water Year

Below is our District-wide projected water budget for the 2022 Water Year ending February 2023. As you can see from the table, our usage is trending higher than what was budgeted for March. In order to stay within our 1,050 AF water supply, we must begin conservation today! This overage in March will impact what's available for the remainder of this water year.
