RESERVE POLICY

The Board of Directors adopted Resolution 2020-01 establishing a Reserve Policy. The policy will provide improved guidance related to reserve planning and financial goal setting, as well as establish the necessary funds for short-term and long-term goals.

AC Pipe Testing

Operator staff has taken another sample of the District's AC pipe along Placer Road just west of Texas Springs. The remaining three sites are being planned to occur in the near future. The Dis-



trict will be testing a total of six samples in different soil types within Centerville to evaluate the AC pipe's current condition as well as better forecast its remaining useful service life. This information will be helpful in planning for future pipeline rehabilitations and replacements.

In order to obtain the AC Pipe sample, water must be shut off in the area of the extraction. <u>Please call the District Office to make sure we have your current contact information on file to ensure you do not miss a notification of any nature.</u>
