## Board of Directors Meeting January 20, 2021

### Audit Report - District Financials for FY ending 6/30/20

Ms. Kayla Horton with Horton, McNulty and Saeturn, LLP, presented her review of the District's Financial Statements for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2020. The Independent Auditor's Report contains the opinions of the accounting firm regarding their review of the District's financial position as of June 30, 2020 and the results of its operations and changes in net assets and cash flow for the year. The review was conducted in conformity with the accounting principles and systems prescribed by the State Controller's Office and State regulations governing Special Districts.



### Annual Report of Discontinuations of Residential Service

Per Senate Bill 998 the Water Shut-off Protection Act, the District is to post an annual report of residential service discontinuations for non-payment. This year the District had one (1) shut-off prior to April 1, 2020. The service was subsequently restored. There were no additional shut-offs during the remainder of the year.

### AC Pipe Condition Assessment Study

The AC Pipe Study was presented to the Board by District Manager Chris Muehlbacher. The study revealed that the District has very acidic soils in numerous areas throughout the District that compromises the life expectancy of the pipe. The study also revealed that the smaller pipe is more impacted. The Board asked that the Resource and Planning Committee continue to review the information in evaluating the system and planning for the future.

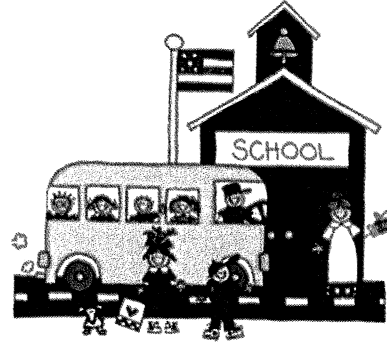


# Help Us Help You....
