The Annual Conference is attended by Managers, Directors, Consultants and Government Agency Representatives from agencies served by the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) facilities in California, Nevada and Oregon. It is a great opportunity to discuss USBR operations, contractor issues, and other concerns and items of interest. The Bureau will also provide a status report on reservoir levels, inflow and discharge measurements along with the Initial Water Supply Outlook for the 2017 water year.
