## Bureau of Reclamation Announces

### 2022-23 WY Allocations !

The Bureau of Reclamation announced the initial water supply allocations for the 2022-23 Water Year (WY). With reservoir storage levels below the historic average and run-off forecasts being limited, the Bureau has allocated enough water for public health and safety needs. This equates to only 55 gallons per day, per person. This year's low allocations are an indicator of the third consecutive dry year California is experiencing and will be updated if conditions warrant.

**What does this mean for the District?** The District will not receive any additional water from Reclamation beyond its 900 AF of Exchange Water. Although the District is in pursuit of purchasing supplemental water it is very likely it will not be enough to match last year's demand of 1,851 AF. As a result we will need to **increase our conservation efforts immediately**. Please review future communications for more details.

Together we can conserve this precious resource and ensure there is water for tomorrow.



## OUTDOOR IRRIGATION RESTRICTIONS

Outdoor use of potable water – **All customers must reduce outdoor use of potable water by adhering to the following restrictions:**

1. Outdoor irrigation is permitted **only** between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 pm to 12:00 am on the days described below:
  - a. Addresses ending with an **odd** number may water only on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday and only within the permitted time period.
  - b. Addresses ending with an **even** number may water only on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday and only within the permitted time period.
  - c. For repair purposes only, outdoor irrigation systems can be operated between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. for a reasonable period of time not to exceed five (5) minutes per zone cycle and only long enough to verify proper operation and make sprinkler adjustments.
