District Receives 100% Allocation for 2024/2025 Water Year!

The Bureau of Reclamation announced the 2024 water supply allocations. Water supply allocations are based on an estimate of water available for delivery and reflect current reservoir storage, precipitation, and snowpack.

The several storms we had since the beginning of 2024, left most of the reservoirs in good shape. The Bureau stated that several storms have boosted the Sierra Nevada snowpack, bringing us to near normal conditions for Northern California.

With the District receiving 100% of its allocation, this water year will be used in the Bureau's calculations when determining how much water Centerville CSD will receive in a future drought. Drought allocations are based upon a three-year water use average when there is no drought present.

This is an excellent year to plant a garden!

Gardening 101

Like the proverbial chicken and egg question, in vegetable gardening it's which comes first, the "What to Plant" question or the "When to Plant" question? Let's start with when to plant.

The best time to plant is after the last frost. However, it is never too late to start preparing your garden area. Over the next few weeks, look for a nice sunny spot in your yard, preferably in a location that is easily accessible from your home that receives 6 to 8 hours of full sun each day. It should be relatively level, well drained, and near a water source. Make sure to plant only as large a garden as you can easily maintain.

Decide if you want raised beds or simply mixing in some herbs and vegetables with your spring and summer landscape.

Begin by clearing the area and tilling up the ground. You may need to add fertilizer and enriched dirt for good soil.

As a general rule of thumb, you can plant your summer vegetable garden in mid-April.

Now, that "What to Plant" question. Always plant vegetables that you and your family like. If you like tomatoes, there are many different varieties to choose from. Get adventurous and plant one you have never tried before. Growing your own vegetables is fun and they always taste better than store bought. And of course if you have extra, you can always can them or freeze dry them for later use.
