Centerville is in its fourth year of a 10-year Tank Coating Program with Superior Tank Solutions. The services include a complete recoating of the tanks, safety improvements and the complete maintenance of all water tanks including full washout cleaning and inspections.

Based upon the schedule, Tank A1 will receive OSHA improvements and coating improvements in April 2025. In preparation for this effort, site improvements will be completed by Zeis Construction at the Tank A1 site to permit temporary water supplies for this zone. These services include building a pad for the five District-owned temporary tanks, delivering and installing the tanks, constructing the manifold piping to the tanks, and constructing a new fire hydrant. The contractor will provide all labor necessary with Centerville providing all required materials.

## District Receive's 100% Allocation for 2025/2026 Water Year!

The Bureau of Reclamation announced the 2025 water supply allocations. Water supply allocations are based on an estimate of water available for delivery and reflect current reservoir storage, precipitation and snowpack.

Recent atmospheric rivers and the good condition of most of our reservoirs going into this water year benefited the water supply outlook.

With the District receiving 100% of their allocation, this water year will be used in the Bureau's calculations when determining how much water Centerville CSD will receive in a future drought. Drought allocations are based upon a three-year water use average when there is no drought present.

This is another excellent year to plant a garden!



### STOP for the School Bus, It's the law!

With the District Office residing on Placer Road, we have received numerous calls about vehicles not stopping for the school bus.

It is important to know that California Vehicle Code section 22454(a) requires drivers to stop for any school bus that stops and displays a flashing red light signal and stop signal arm. To be clear, you must stop if you drive in the opposite direction or the same direction of a school bus that comes to a flashing stop on a two-lane, undivided road.



If you witness a driver not stopping for a school bus which clearly has the STOP sign out and the lights flashing, get their license plate number and turn them in by calling 1-800-TELL-CHP. We all must do our part to keep our kids safe.
