#### Operations & Maintenance Budget for Fiscal Year 2019-20

The Board of Directors unanimously adopted a balanced O & M Budget in the amount of \$1,193,600.

#### Adoption of Ordinance 2019-01, Amending Ordinance 96-1, Section 2,

Plant Capacity Fees: In accordance with the District's Water Master Plan's Capital Improvement Plan Schedule, the Board of Directors unanimously adopted Ordinance 2019-01 amending Ordinance 96-1, Section 2 Capacity Fees. Effective July 1, 2019 the adopted Capacity Fees for new meters will be:

At the hearing, the proposed rate increases will be presented and the public will be given an opportunity to comment. If adopted, the proposed changes will become effective July 1, 2019. 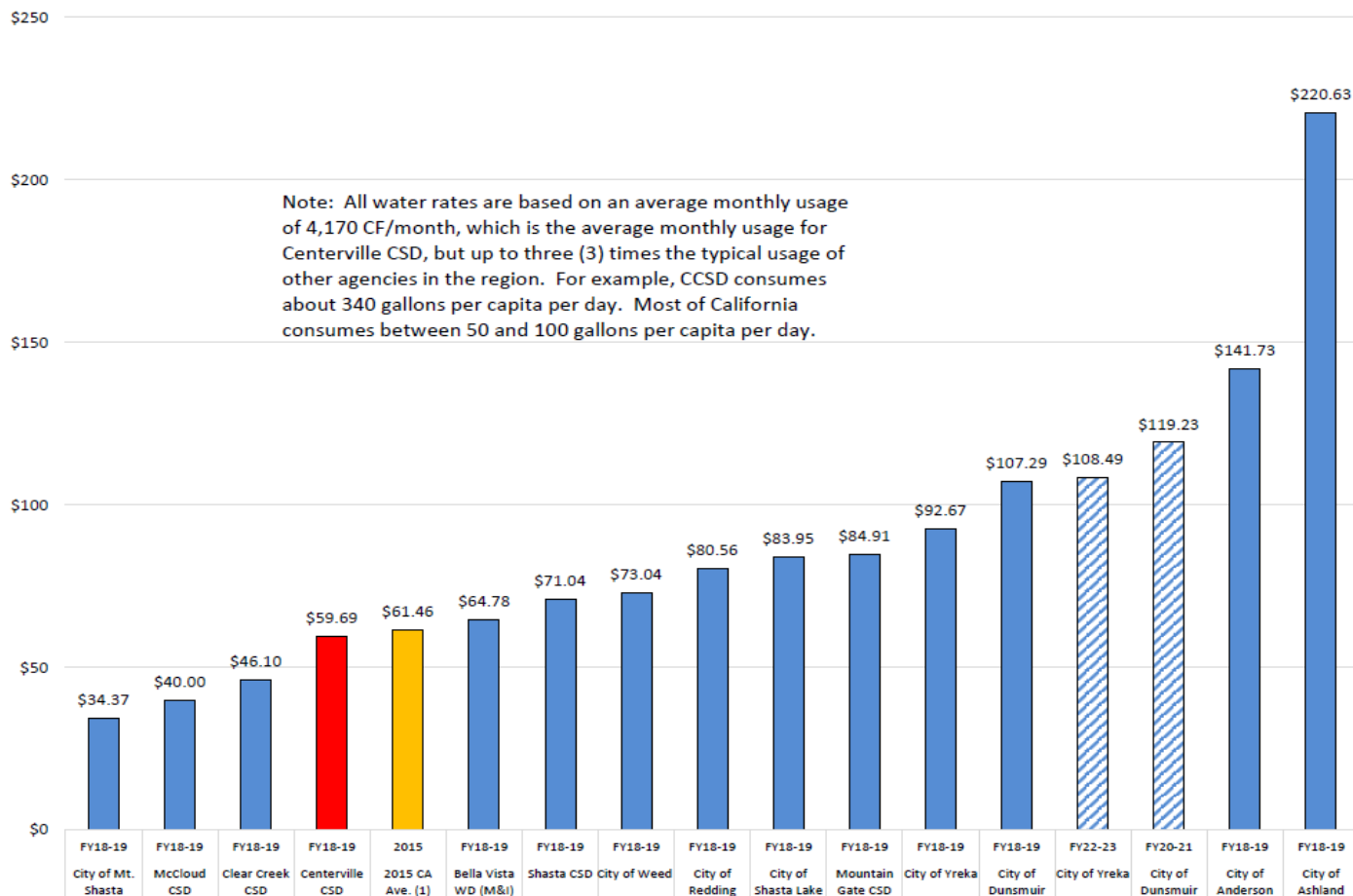

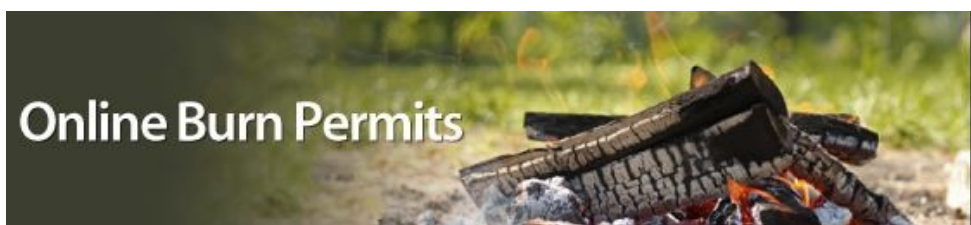


# Rate Comparison with Surrounding Agencies
